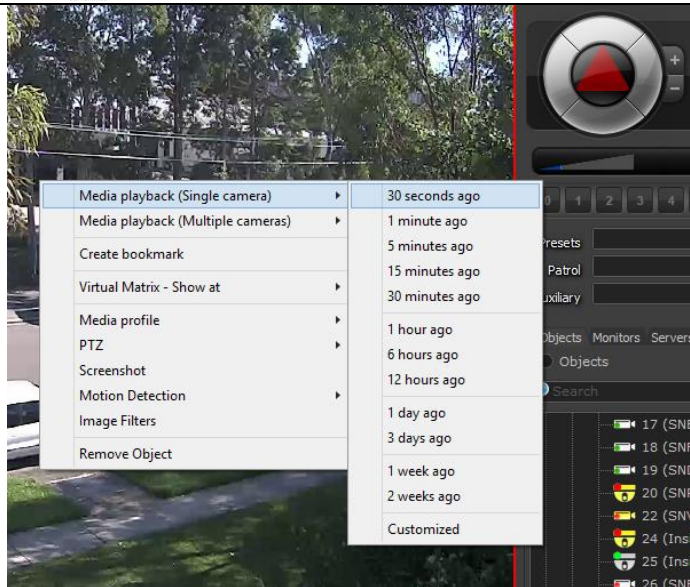

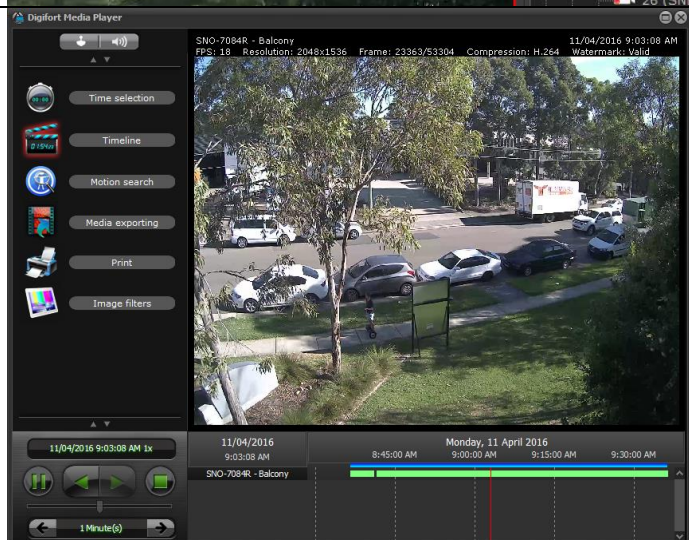

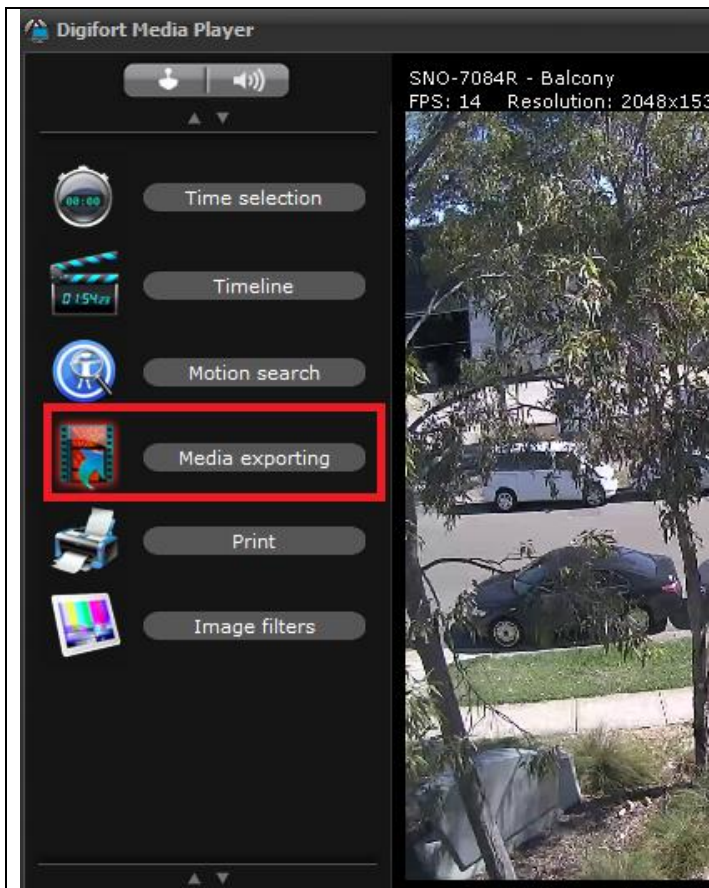
Double click the 'Surveillance Client' icon on the desktop.



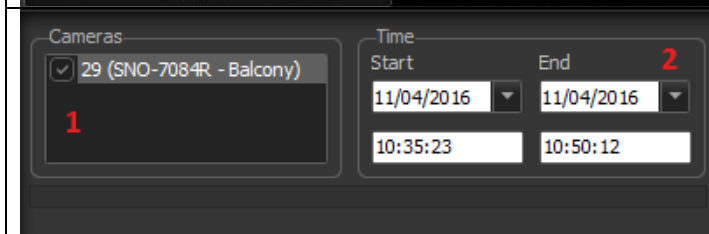
Right click a camera and select 'Media Playback' to playback previous recorded footage.



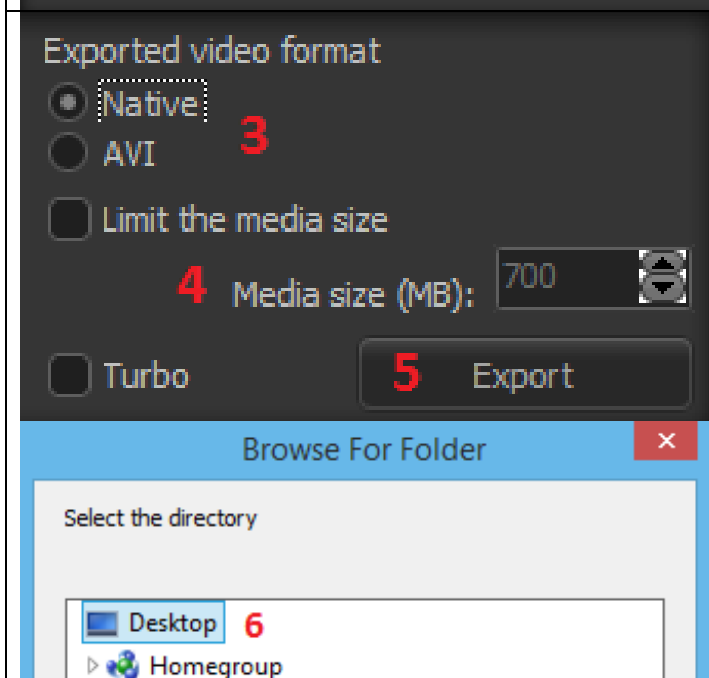
A 'Digifort Media Player' screen should now pop up.






1. Click on 'Media Exp.orting'



1. Select which cameras you want to backup by clicking on the checkbox and putting a tick next to the camera name.
2. Input the 'Start' and 'End' time



3. Select video format:
 - Native:** This is a proprietary Digifort format. This allows format comes with the Digifort Media Player with full functionality and watermarks. We recommend this format.
 - AVI:** This is a video format commonly used in CCTV. This format will take longer to export due to the conversion process. This format is also watermarked.
4. Limiting the media size will compromise video quality.
5. Starts the export process.
6. Choose a folder to save the file to

	<p>7. Enter the details for the backup and then click OK</p>
	<p>The progress bar will indicate how much time left until the export process is completed.</p>
	<p>Once the process is complete, a completion message will pop up. You can now playback your footage from the destination path. Note: Always make sure there is enough space on the desired Hard drive or USB stick you are trying to export the footage on.</p>
